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Dear Parent/Carer

Since September, all pupils have been using Blended Learning Booklets in their subjects to support the curriculum. Following the most recent government announcement of a further national lockdown we will be basing online learning around the Spring A booklets. It is important to remember that we recognise that learning will take place in all manner of ways and it will not be a one size fits all approach, each household has different circumstances, and we want to support you in any way we can.

Many pupils were provided with paper copies of the Spring A booklets before the Christmas break. All booklets will be attached to each lesson set by their class teachers on ClassCharts. In case there are any log-in issues, copies of the Spring A booklets will also be available on the Academy website. They will be accessible within the 'Learning' tab in a folder called 'Home Learning during Lockdown' as PDFs. This means that they cannot be edited so pupils who are accessing the booklets from the Academy website will need to complete the work either in class books or on paper. The only Blended Learning Booklets which will not be available from the Academy website are KS4 Science booklets. If your child(ren) needs any help accessing Years 9-11 Science booklets, please message their Science teacher on ClassCharts for help.

Pupils should plan to complete the work set for lessons during their timetabled slots. In many cases, teachers will have either uploaded short videos to support the lessons in the Blended Learning Booklets or be online for 'live lessons.' Where possible, pupils should upload their work onto Teams to allow them to receive regular feedback from their class teachers. Within the booklets themselves, pupils will find a range of activities including links to online resources such as BBC Bitesize, Seneca and Oak Academy.

We do ask that pupils engage with the booklets and thank you for supporting your child(ren) with these.
