They are used to show belonging or possession, for example, 'that's **my** mum' (the mum belongs to me!)

In French, you use 'mon', 'ma', & 'mes' mean 'my'.

- You use 'mon' in front of male people/things. E.g. 'mon oncle'.
- You use 'ma' in front of female people/things. E.g. 'ma sœur'.
- You use 'mes' when referring to more than one person/thing. E.g. 'mes cousins'




